The Harrisburg Camera Club is hosting a workshop for recent users of digital cameras, both point-and- shoot and DSLRs, in Camp Hill on Friday, February 5, 2010.

Content of the workshop will include:

- Learn the essential settings on your camera to simplify shooting
- Secrets of excellent composition
- Best ways to capture intimate shots of family members
- How to shoot memorable landscapes and scenics

The workshop is led by Al Holliday, long-time workshop leader, as well as publisher of *Pennsylvania Magazine*, known since 1981 for its excellent photos taken mainly by amateur photographers.

The workshop will run from 7 to 9 p.m. February 5, at the Giant supermarket, 32nd St. and Trindle Rd, Camp Hill in the Seibert Room, on the second floor.

The cost of the workshop is \$39 a person, and includes a current membership in the Harrisburg Camera Club. Fee for current HCC members is \$19.

Because of the size of the room, attendance is limited to the first 25 persons who register. Use the form to the right to reserve your spot. Note that the deadline to register is Feb. 1, to allow time for last minute instructions from the workshop leader.
